















La Baraque Integrated Cane Cluster

Centralisation of Milling Operations to La Baraque









Why Bonsucro?



- Focused on sugarcane sustainability.

- End product (Sugar/Ethanol) can be marketed and traded as Bonsucro Certified.











In September 2019, Omnicane became the first African mill to be Bonsucro certified











Our Bonsucro Certification in Figures





- Area covered by the certification:2,500 Ha
- Percentage of cane supply area covered:20%
- Annual volume of Bonsucro Certified sugar produced:
 18,000 tonnes
- Annual Volume of Bonsucro EU RED compliant ethanol produced:
 - 1.5 million litres















Collaboration with Planters' Community

Setting up of Planters Advisory Department by Omnicane Milling in 2015



- Challenge: tackle the issue of field abandonment and reduced productivity from small planters.
- Objective: Provide total management service to small planters.
- Key Figures:
 - ✓ Total Acreage under our supervision:318 arpents = 8,840 tonnes of cane
 - ✓ Total Management: 72 planters
 - Plantation, Maintenance of fields (manual and chemical weeding, fertilisation etc.), Harvest, Loading & Transport of canes
 - ✓ Partial Management: 6 Planters
 - Harvest, Loading & Transport of canes to the Factory

 - Direct Consumption raws for Export







Global Rock Candy Market Report Summary



- Market is estimated at US\$ 603.0m in 2020
- Market is expected to reach US\$ 857.4m by end of 2023
- Europe has the highest value share of 32.7% followed by North America which has a market value of US\$ 157.3m
- Middle East and Africa Market Volume is estimated at 4,274 tonnes in 2020.
- The global volume is estimated at 56,472 tonnes in 2020 and expected to reach 77,076 tonnes by end of 2023.
- Consumers from South Africa and East Asia are increasingly moving towards the consumption of flavourful rock candies.

Organisation, Process & Business Model



- Retail Department established in 2017, under the Refinery management.
- Today a separate business entity, Omnicane International Trading Limited (OITL).
- Process: produce and sell finished packed products from bulk sugars.
- Business model: Generate revenue from DINA branded products on local market and export market, and also own-brand products and contract packing.








Production Capacities (annual, on 1 shift)



- Up to 2,000 T free flowing sugars in pillow packs (1kg and 2kg) or block bottom packs (500g, 1kg and 2kg). Automatically packed on form, fill and seal machines.
- Up to 75 T free flowing sugars in 4g sticks. Automatically packed on a 5-lane stick machine.
- Up to 270 T of DINA LIFE blended sugar.
- Cube process (outsourced with Tropical Cubes) limited to +/- 50
 T. Our own processing method currently under development.
